



## Bench to Bedside Opioid Addiction Research Workshop.

Do you have an interest in biomedical research? Have you ever thought about how researchers develop in-depth meaningful studies focused on addiction? Have you encountered family and/or friends with an addiction to opioids and have a desire to learn more about the disorder? Would you like to know how to help someone who has overdosed on opioids? If you have answered yes to one or more of these questions, we invite you to participate in a one-day workshop hosted by the IDeA Network of Biomedical Research Excellence (INBRE) at the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS).

We will explore addiction research using simulated patients with opioid use disorder. The simulated demonstration would be followed by roundtable discussions with scientists, PhDs and MDs, from across the research spectrum (bench studies to bedside therapies) who will discuss with you how their work contributes to development of treatments for opioid use disorder along with other addiction disorders.

The goals of this workshop are to help students understand the role of translational research (bench to bedside) in contributing to the development of evidence based treatments.

- 1) Simulate use of evidence-based treatment for opioid use disorder
- 2) Identify contributions of different domains of science
